

# BURN 900

Separett Burn is a wood-fired stove for incinerating the dry waste from urine-separating toilets. The principle is based on the latrine bag from the urine-separating toilet being placed on a grating in the stove. Placed below the grating is wood which is then lit. In this way the bag with the dry waste is incinerated and only ash remains. The volume of wood used determines how good the incineration will be.

Separett Burn works in all temperatures, should be positioned outdoors and preferably under a roof when not being used. It is made of Corten plate and has a brown coloured rust-like surface which protects it from rusting away.

## EASY TO USE



1.5-2 kg logs and some chiselled wood inserted into the lower door.



The bag with the dry waste from the toilet should be placed on the grid by opening the lid on top.



For combustion to be optimized adjust the air supply by turning the damper attached to the lower door.

## STORAGE

When not used, Separett Burn should be stored under a roof.

## INCLUDED WITH THE BURN 900

– Burn 900 comes complete with all the parts needed for assembly.

## INSTALLATION

Install Burn according to the following instructions.



- When using Separett Burn, it must be on an open surface, standing firmly and on a flat surface.
- Keep in mind that no trees or branches hang over the product.
- Keep an eye on children and animals so they are not around during incineration.
- When in use, always have a bucket of water handy.

Consider the wind direction when using Burn. Odor occurs during the incineration process.

Separett Burn must never be in use under a roof or indoors.
